- **conspicuous** - easily seen; apparent (page 701)
 - Megan passed the note to Cassidy in a **conspicuous** manner, therefore Ms. Wara took it away.
- **unabashed** - not ashamed or self conscious; bold (page 706)
 - Ashton is **unabashed** about his amazing dance skills.
- **loathe** - to regard with extreme disgust; hate; (page 709)
 - Tristan **loathes** the taste of squid tentacles.
- **vile** - very bad; unpleasant; foul (page 715)
 - Zach, on the other hand, finds the taste of snails **vile**.
- **indignantly** - with dignified anger in response to an insult or injustice (page 718)
 - Joey **indignantly** stomped out of the room after Mr. Kuenster took his last piece of candy.
- **aggravating** - irritating; annoying (page 718)
 - Maddie found Jake's pencil tapping **aggravating** and asked him to stop.
- **subdued** - quiet and downcast (page 725)
 - Dylan's **subdued** behavior in class causes few distractions.
- **jubilation** - great joy and excitement (page 736)
 - Daniel and Brianna enjoyed the **jubilation** and danced until the sun came up.
